She has shown recent improvement and may be worth watching.

He too is down in class and the change of scenery appears to have brought out his better form. **Palermo** (4) has shown his best recent form on the poly but he is in good shape and must rate a decent chance. **One Irish Rover** (1) has been close-up in his last two on the poly. That form has panned out quite well.

**Race Preview:** Benni In The Area (1) has the best of the draw and is over his favourite course and distance. Irish Luck (8) has been close-up in his last four starts on the poly. He has gone close over course and distance and must have a strong chance here. Sweeper Keeper (4) is 1.5kg better off with Rafiki when last they met beaten a short head. Wendy Whiteheads runner should be able to win the tables. Rafiki (7) is a late bloomer having won his last two as a five-year-old. However, he got a five pound shunt up the handicap for his last effort which could put paid to his chances.
