We Have Touchdown has been rested and gelded, he is a lovely horse with lots of ability, if he doesn't need the run badly, he could certainly earn for the connections.

Bounceback was only beaten just under two lengths in his last start, on his best form, he could sneak into the places.

Prevalence finished just under three lengths behind his stable companion last time, he has dropped two points in the ratings from his last run, and he gets a good draw, he could be some value in a tricky race. Lightning Glow should enjoy the step up in trip back to 1800m, he is a gorgeous looking gelding with lots of potential, watch him closely.
